#### **TEAMS**

All Club teams will be **3-person** teams. Club Teams with only 2 players will submit a team with one player fighting twice. Mixed club teams may be created by the organizer by those who are not participating any team.

Final team lineups must be submitted as soon as opening ceremonies are over and no changes are allowed unless there is an injury.

#### **RULES**

Matches are 3 minutes long with 2-one minute *Encho* (time extension). There will be *Hantei* (judge's decision) except for semi-final and final matches, where the *Encho* will be unlimited time until a winner is determined.

The tournament rules will follow "The Regulations of Kendo Shiai and Shinpan (September 2nd, 2017 - "The Regulations" and subsequent corrections)", published by International Kendo Federation (FIK). In addition, Shinpan will apply the Provisional Match and Referee Rules as developed by All Japan Kendo Federation (ZNKR). It will be all participants and volunteers' responsibility to be aware of these rule.

BCKF is not responsible for any valuables lost or stolen, please keep close watch of your belongings. Please place all *bogu* and *shinia* bags on the bleachers in your designated dojo area.

#### **COVID-19 PREVENTION MEASURES**

Everybody within the tournament facility (competitors, shinpans, volunteers, coaches, and spectators) must wear mask. #### **Expectations**

- All attendees at the British Columbia Kendo Federation(BCKF) 2022 Junior Tournament (the tournament) of players, coaches, court officials, referees, tournament volunteers and spectators\* ensure to follow by the guidelines for Kendo shiai and shinpan, and principles of good sportsmanship;
- All attendees\* respect their club/dojo members, coaches, court officials, referees, opponents, opposing coaches and other participants including BCIT facility staff in the tournament and related activity.
- All attendees\* conduct themselves in a manner that minimizes the risk of injury, both physical and psychological, to themselves and others which includes refraining absolutely from making any derogatory comments as to another individual's race, ethnic origin, colour, religion, gender and/or sexual orientation:
- All attendees\* refrain from criticism of players, coaches, court officials, referees, other club/dojo members, opponents, opposing coaches and other participants in the tournament including BCIT facility staff and other tournament activities and, when any attendee feels that criticism is warranted, the BCKF board of directors shall offer it in a manner that is fully respectful, through proper channels and away from the tournament area in any event;
- All attendees\* refrain from directing comments which are insulting, intimidating, humiliating, hurtful, malicious, degrading or otherwise offensive to players, court officials, referees and the tournament volunteers including but not restricted to head instructors of the member dojo/club, board members, executive members (directors) and coaches. If any attendee feels that criticism of any such person is warranted, the person shall be offered by any of the BCKF board of directors in a manner that is fully respectful, through proper channels and away from the tournament area in any event.
